WAR SHIPPING ADMINISTRATION.

The Coast Guard has received information from a reliable source concerning Robert Raymond, chief cook, on the SS FRANCES E. WILLARD. Report states that Raymond has been the cause of considerable trouble and dissention aboard this vessel during its present voyage. On one occasion, when in Suva, he threatened to knife the chief steward.

The Coast Guard will investigate whatever disciplinary action is warranted in this case.
