TRANSFER ORDER NO. C-5990

Approving the Sale Alien of the

St. Sc. FRANCIS W. PETTYGROVE


WHEREAS, The United States Maritime Commission, on December 19, 1947, authorized the sale of its steam screw FRANCIS W. PETTYGROVE, Official No. 243185, to Venturi, Salvataggi, Ricuperi E Imprese Marittime, Soc., Per Azioni, a company established and existing under the laws of the Republic of Italy, with offices in Genoa, Italy, pursuant to Contract No. MCC-61044, dated February 10, 1948, which provides that the hull or hulk of said vessel shall be completely scrapped, dismembered, dismantled, or destroyed:

IT IS ORDERED, This 18th day of February 1948, that the approval required by Sections 9 and 41 of the Shipping Act, 1916, as amended (46 U.S.C. 808 and 839), of the sale of the steam screw FRANCIS W. PETTYGROVE, Official No. 243185, to an alien, as above set forth, be, and it is hereby granted.
