Approving the Sale Alien and Transfer  
to Canadian Registry and Flag of the  
S/S FRED L. HEWITT

WHEREAS, An application has been filed by Bison Steamship Corporation, Buffalo, New York, for the approval required by Sections 9 and 37 of the Shipping Act 1916, as amended (46 U.S.C. 808 and 835) of the sale of the steam screw FRED L. HEWITT (ex-GRAHAM C. WOODRUFF), Official No. 205009, to Colonial Steamships, Limited, Port Colborne, Ontario, with transfer to Canadian registry and flag:


IT IS ORDERED, This 15th day of April 1947, that the approval required by Sections 9 and 37 of the Shipping Act 1916, as amended (46 U.S.C. 808 and 835), of the sale of the steam screw FRED L. HEWITT (ex-GRAHAM C. WOODRUFF), Official No. 205009, to an alien as above set forth, with transfer to Canadian registry and flag, be, and it is hereby granted, upon the condition that there shall be no liens or encumbrances recorded against said vessel in the Customhouse at its last United States home port at the time its transfer to foreign ownership, registry and flag is effected; and

IT IS ORDERED FURTHER, That this approval shall be null and void unless the sale alien and transfer to foreign registry and flag, hereby approved, are effected within six months of the date of such approval.
