MEMORANDUM FOR THE CHAIRMAN OF THE CREW DISCIPLINARY COMMITTEE,
WAR SHIPPING ADMINISTRATION.

The Coast Guard has received information from a reliable source concerning Francisco Pellet, dishwasher, on the SS FREDERICK REMINGTON. Report states that Pellet on May 31, 1943, while his vessel was in Durban, became intoxicated, refused his duties, attacked and threatened to knife the chief steward.

The Coast Guard will instigate whatever disciplinary action is warranted in this case.
