5 May, 1945 enroute to Mediterranean Area.

1. A check of the crew list through the files of this office revealed Merchant Marine Personnel Circular #86 lists BECKMANN, William, Z-283356, as wanted for hearing. Upon being notified of this information, Lt. R. E. KING, Merchant Marine Hearing Officer, Savannah, Georgia, advised that BECKMANN was no longer wanted for a hearing as Headquarters' Dispatch 021559 (May, 1945) stated SUBJECT was cleared on 27 May, 1944 for Misconduct aboard the SS "HAMLIN GARLAND".

CARR holds United States Passport No. 787916, and British Certificate of Identification No. 1328 issued 11 November, 1943. CARR departed the United States at New York aboard the British flag vessel "PROMETHEUS" in January, 1944. SUBJECT stated that he was to report to the Field Director American Field Service, New York, upon departing Savannah, Georgia.
