ITINERARY: Vessel arrived Savannah, Georgia, at 2230, 21 April, 1945, from India.

1. The crew list was checked through the files of this office with negative results. The following person, who signed aboard Subject vessel at Calcutta, India was interrogated and fingerprinted. Forms 2765 and 2515 are forwarded herewith:

CARR, Leslie Richard, an Ambulance Driver for the American Field Service, serving in India and Burma since January, 1944, who holds no Maritime Documents, signed on Subject vessel as Wiper at Calcutta, India, on 5 March, 1945, for transportation back to the United States. CARR holds United States Passport No. 787916, and British Certificate of Identification No. 1328 issued 11 November, 1943. CARR departed the United States at New York aboard the British flag vessel "PROMETHEUS" in January, 1944. SUBJECT stated that he was to report to the Field Director American Field Service, New York, upon departing Savannah, Georgia.
