Approving the Charter to an Alien of the Tanker FRENCH CREEK

WHEREAS, By its Order No. CH-1028, dated March 11, 1948, the Maritime Commission approved the charter of the tanker FRENCH CREEK, Official No. 246966, by Cities Service Oil Company of New York, to Anglo-Saxon Petroleum Company, Ltd., a British corporation, for four consecutive voyages covering the transportation of petroleum products, as follows: loading at a port or ports in the United States Gulf/Caribbean for discharging at a port or ports in the United Kingdom/Continent/Bordeaux-Hamburg Range, lay days March 15 - March 30, 1948; and

WHEREAS, A request has now been received for a modification of the above approval, so as to permit said vessel to discharge in the following port or ports in South America, Buenos Aires, and/or Montevideo and/or La Plata; and ports in Scandinavia;

IT IS ORDERED, This 30th day of April 1948, that the approval of the Maritime Commission as set forth in Order No. CH-1028, dated March 11, 1948, be, and it is hereby modified so as to permit the tanker FRENCH CREEK, Official No. 246966 to discharge at a port or ports on the east coast and ports in Scandinavia, all other terms of the Commission's original approval to remain unchanged.
