TRANSFER ORDER NO. C-4643

Approving the Sale Alien and Transfer to
Panamaian Registry and Flag of the
Tanker FRENCHTOWN

WHEREAS, An application has been filed by Standard Oil Company, New York, N.Y., prospective owner of the tanker FRENCHTOWN, Official No. 245196, for the approval required by Sections 9 and 37 of the Shipping Act 1916, as amended (46 U.S.C. 808 and 835), of the sale of said vessel to Panama Transport Company, a Panamaian corporation, with transfer to Panamaian registry and flag:


IT IS ORDERED, This 5th day of November, 1946, that the approval required by Sections 9 and 37 of the Shipping Act 1916, as amended (46 U.S.C. 808 and 835) of the sale of the tanker FRENCHTOWN, Official No. 245196, to an alien as set forth above, with transfer to Panamaian registry and flag, be, and it is hereby granted, upon the condition that there shall be no liens or encumbrances on record against said vessel in the Customhouse at its last United States home port at the time its transfer to foreign ownership, registry and flag is effected; and

IT IS ORDERED FURTHER, That this approval shall be null and void unless the sale alien and transfer to foreign registry and flag, hereby approved, are effected within six months of the date of such approval.
