Approving the Sale Alien and Transfer
to Honduran Registry and Flag of the
S/S GEORGE H. THOMAS

WHEREAS, The United States Maritime Commission on November 8, 1946, authorized the sale of the S/S GEORGE H. THOMAS, Official No. 242311, to Constantine Konialidis, a Uruguayan citizen, with the privilege of transferring said vessel to foreign registry and flag:


IT IS ORDERED, This 6th day of January 1947, that the approval required by Sections 9 and 37 of the Shipping Act 1916, as amended (46 U.S.C. 808 and 835) of the sale of the S/S GEORGE H. THOMAS, Official No. 242311, to an alien as above set forth, with transfer to Honduran registry and flag, be, and it is hereby granted.
