Subj: War action casualty involving SS GEORGE MATTHEWS

1. Reference is made to your letter dated 5 October, 1944 (MIN-628-C2767), wherein it is indicated that the SS GEORGE MATTHEWS was involved in a war action casualty, having been attacked and strafed by enemy aircraft on 11 July, 1944, without any resulting loss of life, although two persons received shrapnel wounds.

2. In view of the foregoing and in accordance with existing HQ instructions, Captain R.F. Albrecht, Master of the SS GEORGE MATTHEWS, should have executed form 924d-1, while he was being interviewed with respect to form 924e.

3. If Captain Albrecht is available in your district, it is desired that information for form 924d-1 be procured from him and submitted to Headquarters. If he is not available, all possible information obtainable as to his whereabouts should be submitted to HQ which will aid in locating him for the purpose above indicated.
