Approving the Sale Alien and Transfer to Argentine Registry and Flag of the Steam Screw Tanker GULFMAID

WHEREAS, An application has been filed by Gulf Oil Corporation, Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, for the approval required by Sections 9 and 37 of the Shipping Act 1916, as amended (46 U.S.C. 808 and 835), of the sale of the steam screw tanker GULFMAID, Official No. 214827, to "Estrella Maritima S.A. de Navegacion y Comercio", Buenos Aires, Argentina, with transfer to Argentine registry and flag:

IT IS ORDERED, This 19th day of November, 1946, that the approval required by Sections 9 and 37 of the Shipping Act 1916, as amended (46 U.S.C. 808 and 835), of the sale of the steam screw tanker GULFMAID, Official No. 214827, to an alien as above set forth, with transfer to Argentine registry and flag, be, and it is hereby granted upon the condition that there shall be no liens or encumbrances on record against said vessel in the Customhouse at its last United States home port at the time its transfer to foreign ownership, registry and flag is effected; and

IT IS ORDERED FURTHER, That this approval shall be null and void unless the sale alien, and the transfer to foreign registry and flag, hereby approved, are effected within six months of the date of such approval.
