GUNS: One 4" 50 Cal. Placed aft on a Platform.

AMMUNITION: 94 Rds 4" 50 Cal. T.N.T and Tracer.

SMALL ARMS: Two Colt 30 Cal Machine Guns. Placed above the Pilot House  
one on each side.

AMMUNITION: 2800 Rds 30 Cal Colt Machine Gun. Tracer ang Ball.

MAGAZINE: One foreward under the Forecastle Head.

FIRE CONTROL AND COMMUNICATION EQUIPMENT: Sprinkler system. Telephone  
from Gun deck to the Bridge.

GUNS CREWS: Four men, Sea 1/c in charge and three Sea 2/c.

REMARKS: Vessel is Degaused, has placement for two Anti-Aircraft Machine  
Guns aft on top of the house. Three ammunition ready boxes on the Gun Platform.
