SMALL ARMS: Two Colt Machine 30 Cal. mounted on top of Pilot House.  
Two revolvers, 38 Cal.

AMMUNITION: 2300 rounds Colt Machine Tracer and Ball. 40 rounds  
revolver, 38 Cal.

MAGAZINE: One under Forecastle Head.

FIRE CONTROL AND COMMUNICATION EQUIPMENT: Sprinkler.  
Telephone from Gun to Bridge.

GUNS CREWS: Four, Cox in charge and 3 Sea. 2c.

REMARKS: Vessel is degaused, has three ready boxes on gun platform.  
Placement for two anti-aircraft guns aft on top of the house.
