TRANSFER ORDER NO. C-4419

Approving the Charter to an Alien and the Transfer
to Philippine Registry and Flag of the Oil
Screw Vessel HALEAKAIA.

WHEREAS, An application has been filed by Inter-Island Steam Navigation Company, Ltd., Honolulu, T.H., for the approval required by Sections 9 and 37 of the Shipping Act 1916, as amended (46 U.S.C. 808 and 835), of the transfer of the oil screw HALEAKAIA, Official No. 222693, to Philippine registry and flag, incident to the charter of said vessel to The De La Rama Steamship Company, Incorporated, a Philippine corporation, for a period of three years, commencing on or about June 15, 1946, for operation in the transportation of passengers and cargo between ports in the Philippine Islands and ports on the coast of China:


IT IS ORDERED, this 14th day of June 1946, that the approval required by Sections 9 and 37 of the Shipping Act 1916, as amended (46 U.S.C. 808 and 835), of the transfer of the oil screw HALEAKAIA, Official No. 222693, to Philippine registry and flag, and the charter of said vessel to a Philippine corporation for operation as above set forth, be, and it is hereby granted, upon the condition that there shall be no liens nor encumbrances on record against said vessel in the Customhouse at its last United States home port at the time its transfer to foreign registry and flag is effected; and

IT IS ORDERED FURTHER, That this approval shall be null and void unless the transfer to foreign registry and flag and charter to an alien, hereby approved, are effected within six months of the date of such approval.
