I have the honor to refer to my despatch No. 53 dated September 4, 1943 concerning the sentence of six months hard labor for housebreaking, theft and assault given Fred W. SETZER, Fireman from the S.S. JOHN SEDGWICK in July 1943.

Setzer completed his sentence in November and was repatriated on the S.S. HAWLEY.
