1. Position-Sea-Weather 66°39'N, 22°33'W; fog and rough.
2. Convoy or Independent Convoy.
3. Time & Kind of 1st Hit 2125 - 1 torpedo.
4. Location of 1st Hit #2 hold starboard side.
5. Effect of 1st Hit Damaged steering gear; steam line in engine room carried away.
6. Time & Reason for Abandonment or Why Not 2200 (25 min.) - ship settling rapidly, beyond control.
7. Persons Aboard - 62 Lost by drowning - 1.
8. Time & Kind of 2nd Hit 2128 (3 min.) - 1 torpedo.
9. Location of 2nd Hit #5 hold starboard side.
10. Effect of 2nd Hit Ship took a list and began settling rapidly.
11. Disposition of Vessel Sunk 2400 (2 hours, 35 min.).
12. Time & Kind of 3rd Hit 2133 (8 min.) - 1 torpedo.
13. Location of 3rd Hit Machinery spaces starboard side.
14. Effect of 3rd Hit Extensive damage to machinery and hull, flooded.
15. Time & Kind of 4th Hit 2200 - 2 torpedoes.
16. Location of 4th Hit Somewhere below water line on starboard side.
17. Effect of 4th Hit Extensive damage.
