TRANSFER ORDER NO. C-4652

Approving the Transfer to Panamaian Registry and Flag of the SS HEGIRA

WHEREAS, By its Transfer Order No. C-4360, dated April 5, 1946, the Maritime Commission approved the sale of the SS HEGIRA, Official No. 218209, by Weyerhaeuser Steamship Company to Constantine Konialidis, a Uruguayan citizen, with transfer to Honduran registry and flag;

WHEREAS, Constantine Konialidis applied for and obtained Panamaian registry for said vessel in lieu of Honduran registry and flag in violation of the terms of the above-referred to Order; and

WHEREAS, After compromise settlement of said illegal transfer and in order to cure the doubtful legality thereof, Constantine Konialidis has applied for the Commission's approval of the transfer of said vessel to Panamaian registry and flag:

IT IS ORDERED, This 8th day of November, 1946, That the approval required by Sections 9 and 37 of the Shipping Act 1916, as amended (46 U.S.C. 808 and 835), of the transfer of the SS HEGIRA, Official No. 218209 (renamed MEROPE), by Constantine Konialidis, a Uruguayan citizen, to Panamaian registry and flag be, and is hereby granted, and

IT IS ORDERED FURTHER, That this approval shall be null and void unless the transfer to foreign registry and flag as above set forth is effected within three months of the date of this approval.
