Approving the Sale Alien and Transfer
to Panamanian Registry and Flag of the

St. Sc. HENRY WHITE


WHEREAS, The United States Maritime Commission on April 15, 1947, authorized the sale of its steam screw HENRY WHITE, Official No. 245631, to John A. Cosmas, a citizen of the United States of America, with address at 540 Adelaide Drive, Santa Monica, California, with the privilege of transferring said vessel to Compania Maritima Samsoc Limitada, S. A., a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the Republic of Panama, which is wholly-owned by said John A. Cosmas, and with the further privilege of transferring said vessel to foreign registry and flag:

IT IS ORDERED, This 7th day of August, 1947, that the approval required by Section 9 of the Shipping Act 1916, as amended (46 U.S.C. 808), of the transfer of the steam screw HENRY WHITE, Official No. 245631, by John A. Cosmas, to Compania Maritima Samsoc Limitada, S. A., a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the Republic of Panama, and the transfer of said vessel to Panamanian ownership, registry and flag, be, and it is hereby granted.
