Approving the Sale Alien and Transfer to  
Panamaian Registry and Flag of the  
Steam Screw HERMAN F. WHITON

WHEREAS, An application has been filed by Pacific Tankers, Inc., on behalf of Olympic Whaling Company, Inc., New York, N.Y., for the approval required by Section 9 of the Shipping Act 1916, as amended (46 U.S.C. 808), of the sale of the Steam Screw HERMAN F. WHITON (ex-OREGON TRAIL), Official No. 244576, to Transatlantica Financiera Industrial, S. A., a Panamaian corporation with offices in Montevideo, Uruguay, and the transfer of said vessel to Panamaian registry and flag:


IT IS ORDERED, This 11th day of August 1950, that the approval required by Sections 9 and 41 of the Shipping Act 1916, as amended (46 U.S.C. 808 and 839), of the sale of the Steam Screw HERMAN F. WHITON (ex-OREGON TRAIL), Official No. 244576, as an alien as above set forth, with transfer to Panamaian registry and flag, be, and it is hereby granted upon the condition that there shall be no liens or encumbrances recorded against said vessel in the Customhouse at its last United States home port at the time its transfer to foreign ownership, registry and flag is effected; and

IT IS ORDERED FURTHER, That this approval shall be null and void unless the sale alien and transfer to foreign registry and flag, hereby approved, are effected within six months of the date of such approval.
