



5. Date seal was broken 1915 CWT 11 March 1943
6. Reason for breaking seal Test transmitters and make any necessary repairs.
7. Name of company and person performing test. E.G. Antonini, Radiomarine Corporation of America
8. Name of Coast Guard personnel breaking seal. James R. Peterson
9. Name of Coast Guard personnel standing Guard L.N. Ridgeway, Sea 2/c
10. Name of Coast Guard personnel resealing radio room James R. Peterson
11. Date and hour of resealing 2025 CWT 11 March 1943
12. Seal. Two (2) wire and lead seals # 2.
13. State whether or not repairs are completed. Testing and repairs completed.
