Subject: Yugoslavian SS "Ivan"; morale report.

1. In accordance with instructions the Yugoslavian SS IVAN was boarded on her arrival at St. Thomas, V.I., 16 December 1941.
2. The morale and the attitude toward the future voyage was found to be good.
3. This vessel is under charter to Saguenay Terminals Limited and is currently employed in a shuttle service hauling bauxite from Georgetown, (MacKenzie) B.G. to St. Thomas, V.I. The charter began 16 September 1941 and will run for 6 months, (3 months plus 3 months extension.
4. It is the opinion of this officer that this vessel is reliable.
