1. The subject vessel is owned by Kap. Ant. Babarovic of Susak, Yugoslavia and is registered at Milna, Yugoslavia. This vessel is under charter to the Saguenay Terminals Limited from 3 September 1941 for three months. Upon expiration of this charter it was extended for three months.

This vessel entered St. Thomas, Virgin Islands on 16 2. December 1941 from Georgetown, British Guiana with a cargo of 1662 tons of bauxite to discharge at this port. The Saguenay Terminals Limited being a British Company, the radio of the vessel was sealed on arrival at this port in compliance with orders.
