1. The subject vessel is owned by Kap. Ant. Babarovic of Susak, Yugoslavia and is registered at Milna, Yugoslavia. This vessel is under charter to the Saguenay Terminals Limited from 3 September 1941 for 3 months. Upon expiration of this charter it was extended for three months.

2. This vessel entered St. Thomas, Virgin Islands on 2 December 1941 from Georgetown, British Guiana with a cargo of 1636 tons of bauxite to discharge at this port. The Saguenay Terminals Limited being a British Company, the radio of the vessel was sealed on arrival at this port in compliance with orders.
