TRANSFER ORDER NO. C-5007 (a)

Approving the Sale Alien and Transfer
to Panamaian Registry and Flag of the
S/S JACK LONDON

WHEREAS, By its Transfer Order No. C-5007, dated January 31, 1947, the Maritime Commission, approved, pursuant to Sections 9 and 37 of the Shipping Act 1916, as amended (46 U.S.C. 808 and 835), the sale of its S/S JACK LONDON, Official No. 243987, to Constantino Konialidis, a citizen of Uruguay, residing at Montivedeo, Uruguay, and the transfer of said vessel to Honduran registry and flag; and


WHEREAS, The new owner has now advised that he desires to place the vessel under Panamaian registry and flag in lieu of Honduran registry and flag, as above set forth, and has requested our approval thereof:

IT IS ORDERED, This 3rd day of February, 1947, that Transfer Order No. C-5007, dated January 31, 1947, be, and it is hereby modified so as to approve the transfer of the S/S JACK LONDON, Official No. 243987, by Constantino Konialidis, a Uruguayan citizen, to Panamaian registry and flag in lieu of Honduran registry and flag, all other conditions of Transfer Order No. C-5007 to remain unchanged.
