Subject Threat among crew members of U.S. merchant ship caused by

1. The above ship was boarded and the seamen papers of the crew examined.
2. All crew members were U. S. Citizens except one, Mohamed Ahmed MOHAMED, an Egyptian, who was previously security endorsed.
3. John EKLUND, a workaway wiper, Z-433964, was returning to spend six months ashore. He had his "C" papers suspended at Bari, Italy, 13 June, 1945, by the Coast Guard Hearing Officer at that place, for a period of six months. He had previously been a crew member of the S/S "ELDRICH", a U. S. Liberty Ship, which set into Bari, 13 June, 1945. He had been an oiler, and had personal diagreements with another oiler, and became drunk, which resulted in this punishment. He was taken off the S/S "ELDRICH", and on 16 June, 1945, he sailed on the SS "JACOB S. MANSFIELD", as a workaway wiper, with the consent of the local shipping authorities. He intends to leave the S/S "JACOB S. MANSFIELD" at Charleston, S. C., and return to his home at 8117 Third Avenue, Brooklyn, N. Y. No endorsement granted.
