Modification of Approval of the Sale Alien and  
Transfer to Foreign Registry and Flag of the  
SS JACOB'S LADDER

WHEREAS, By its Transfer Order No. C-5047, dated February 10, 1947, the Maritime Commission approved, pursuant to Section 37 of the Shipping Act 1916, as amended (46 U.S.C. 835), the sale of the SS JACOB'S LADDER, by Ingalls Shipbuilding Corporation, to Flota Mercante Grancolombiana, a corporation created and existing under the laws of the Republic of Colombia, with transfer to Colombian registry and flag; and


WHEREAS, A request has been received for a modification of the above, so as to approve the transfer of said vessel to Ecuadorian registry and flag in lieu of Colombian registry and flag:

IT IS ORDERED, This 28th day of April 1947, that Transfer Order No. C-5047, dated February 10, 1947, be, and it is hereby modified so as to approve the transfer of the SS JACOB'S LADDER, to Ecuadorian registry and flag in lieu of Colombian registry and flag, all other terms and conditions of the Commission's Transfer Order No. C-5047 to remain unchanged.
