Approving the Sale Alien and Transfer to Colombian Registry and Flag of the undocumented Oil Screw JACOB'S LADDER

WHEREAS, The United States Maritime Commission on November 21, 1946, authorized the sale of the undocumented oil screw JACOB'S LADDER to The Ingalls Shipbuilding Corporation, with the privilege of transferring said vessel to Flota Mercante Grancolombiana, a Colombian corporation, and the transfer of said vessel to Colombian registry and flag:

IT IS ORDERED, This loth day of February 1947, that the approval required by Section 37 of the Shipping Act 1916, as amended (46 U.S.C. 835) of the transfer of the undocumented oil screw JACOB'S LADDER by The Ingalls Shipbuilding Corporation to Flota Mercante Grancolombiana, a Colombian corporation, and the transfer of said vessel to Colombian ownership, registry and flag, be, and it is hereby granted.
