to Greek Registry and Flag of the
S/S JAMES IVES


WHEREAS, The United States Maritime Commission on November 26, 1946, authorized the sale of the S/S JAMES IVES, Official No. 243161, to Livanos Maritime C. O. Ltd., a Greek joint stock company, with the privilege of transferring said vessel to foreign registry and flag:

IT IS ORDERED, This 10th day of January 1947, that the approval required by Sections 9 and 37 of the Shipping Act 1916, as amended (46 U.S.C. 808 and 835) of the sale of the S/S JAMES IVES, Official No. 243161, to an alien as above set forth, with transfer to Greek registry and flag, be, and it is hereby granted.
