

NOTED AFTER SHIPWAS HIT MASTER ORDERED ALL EXCEPT & VOLUNTEERS ABANDON SHIR WITH THE ASSISTANCE OF 8 VOLUNTEERS, HE RIGGED THE TAR PAULINS ON THE FOREMAST & MIZZEN-MAST. HE SAILED THE CRIPPLED SHIP 360 MILES. AN ALLIED SHIP MET & TOWED THEM 450 MILES MAKING A GRAND TOTAL OF 810 MILES TRAVERSED IN A TOTALLY DISABLED SHIP.
