For your information respecting the request made by the Navy for advice of action taken, the charges were investigated by the OICMI, Baltimore, and it was found that although the master probably was non co-operative with the armed guard officer, in the absence of concrete evidence of misconduct or inattention to duty, no action was taken against Mr. Langfeldt's license.
