Resident agent of FBI, Jacksonville, Fla., accompanied by a representative of Zone 4-J, 6ND, presented photographs of Charles P. SCHOTT to Hr. Perry Lee ROWELL, 3453 Brentwood Avenue, Jacksonville, Fla., for identification by him as the seaman who was in his taxicab on May 1, 1943 at 2045, and who discussed cargo and sailing time of SUBJECT vessel. Mr. ROWELL stated that although the man shown in the photographs was dressed the same as the seaman in his taxicab, he was unable to identify him as at no time during the taxicab ride did he see the seaman's face. No further investigation is contemplated by NIS.
