

Wightman formerly fireman-watertender on the 88 JAMES MOORE, Report states that Wightman admitted the theft He was removed from his ship for this offense and subsequently tried by a Military Court, found guilty, fined \$145.00 and sen-

tenced to 30 days hard labor.

The Coast Guard will instigate whatever further disciplinary action is warranted in this case.
