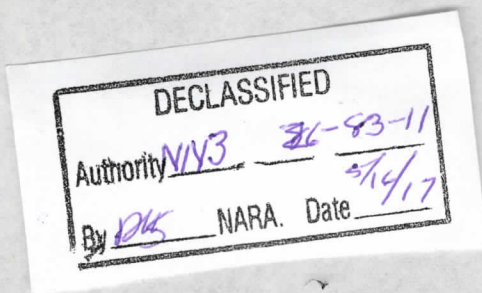

MEMORANDUM FOR THE CHAIRMAN OF THE CREW DISCIPLINARY COMMITTEE,
WAR SHIPPING ADMINISTRATION.

The Coast Guard has received information from a reliable source concerning Alvis J. Wightman formerly fireman-watertender on the SS JAMES MOORE. Report states that Wightman admitted the theft of a case of whisky from the ship's cargo about 31 August, 1943. He was removed from his ship for this offense and subsequently tried by a Military Court, found guilty, fined \$145.00 and sentenced to 30 days hard labor.

The Coast Guard will instigate whatever further disciplinary action is warranted in this case.
