to Italian Registry and Flag of the

St. Sc. JAMES SCREVEN


WHEREAS, The United States Maritime Commission on June 2, 1947, authorized the sale of its steam screw JAMES SCREVEN, Official No. 244713, to the Government of Italy, with the privilege of transferring said vessel to foreign registry and flag:

IT IS ORDERED, This 18th day of July 1947, that the approval required by Sections 9 and 37 of the Shipping Act 1916, as amended (46 U.S.C. 808 and 835), of the sale of the steam screw JAMES SCREVEN, Official No. 244713, to an alien as above set forth, with transfer to Italian registry and flag, be, and it is hereby granted.
