10 of Crew of 68 Saved After 20 Days Adrift

LISBON, Portugal, May 10—Ten survivors of the American Merchantman James W. Denver, torpedoed by a U-boat April 11 while en route to North Africa from the United States, were landed here today by a Portuguese fishing boat.

Fifty-seven of the crew are missing and one, Malcolm Davis, died the day before the survivors were rescued. They had been afloat on the Atlantic about 20 days.
