MEMORANDUM FOR THE CHAIRMAN OF THE CREW DISCIPLINARY COMMITTEE,
WAR SHIPPING ADMINISTRATION.

The Coast Guard has received from a reliable source further information concerning E. R. Small, Master of the JANE A. DELANO. Report alleges that Captain Small, in addition to information previously reported, failed to comply with routing instructions on two occasions during the recently completed voyage of the DELANO. It is further alleged he violated blackout regulations during the trip and refused to cooperate with the Armed Guard regarding violations. It is also intimated Captain Small divulged information to crew members concerning the ship's itinerary.

Present report states, in deference to previous information, that Robert A. Durrett, radio operator, has diligently applied himself to his work and has developed into an entirely satisfactory ship radio operator.

The Coast Guard will instigate whatever disciplinary action is warranted in the case of Captain Small.

The Coast Guard will instigate the necessary disciplinary action in these cases.
