Charge: Misconduct

Plea: Guilty

Facts: That Mr. Joe Broion Thomas was A.W.O.L. from vessel July 21, 22, 23, 24, 25, 26, 27, 28, 29, 30, and 31, 1944, and August 1, 1944. The official Log was checked and showed that Joe B. Thomas had been logged for the above dates.


Conclusion: The evidence was sufficient to prove that Joe B. Thomas was guilty as charged.

Findings: Specification one (1) proved, charge proved.

Order: That Certificate of Service E-347787 be suspended for two (2) months from 2 August, 1944 - with twelve (12) months probation.
