I Sep 43 signed on SS SILVESTER GARDINER in N.Y. harbor 8 Oct 43 as Steward - because of misconduct (fighting and disobedience) with the Chief Steward he was given a Coast Guard trial in Algiers on 1 Dec 43, suspended for 4 months and advised to pay off the SS SILVESTER GARDINER which he did 2 Dec 43. The same day he reported to the US Consul and was signed on the subject vessel as a workaway for repatriation to the US. Subject is to report to MaidU $V$ 27 Dec 43 for a hearing of his case. He enlisted in the U.S.N. in Philadelphis, Pa . on 8 Dec 41 and received an undesirable Discharge from Naval Air Station, Cape May, N.J. on 29 Oct 42 for being A.O.L. He was discharged with the rating of Ship's Cook 3rd class and admitted he went A.O.L. in order to get into the Merchant Marine. Subject passenger did not recall his Navy Serial number.
