Subj: JOHN D. WHIDDEN, U.S.S/S - Crew trouble aboard

Coast Guard has received from a reliable source information concerning the crew aboard the JOHN D. WHIDDEN on a coastwide run during the month of July 1944. The report indicates that the master, Roy M. Cone, stated that there was considerable dissention among the crew. The majority of the crew had expected to sign off the ship in New York having signed on in Great Lakes ports. The ship did not dock in New York but proceeded to Jacksonville, Florida. An enclosure is submitted for your information. This list was prepared by the ship's delegate, Joseph D. Holliday.

The Coast Guard will take such action as seems indicated in the circumstances.
