

NOTE O- I LIFEBORT WAS PICKED OF AFTER 30 DRYS BY AN ALLIED SHIP. OF
THE 8 MEN THAT WERE IN THIS LIFEBORT (6 murchantmen and 3 gunerus),
3 OF THE MERCHANT MEN LATER DIED AT DURBAN, PRESUMABLY FROM EXPOSURE.
