Approving the Sale Alien and Transfer
to South African Registry and Flag of the

St. Sc. JOHN G. NICOLAY


WHEREAS, The United States Maritime Commission on June 26, 1947, authorized the sale of its steam screw JOHN G. NICOLAY, Official No. 243031, to Southern Steamships (Proprietary) Limited, a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the Union of South Africa, with the privilege of transferring said vessel to foreign registry and flag:

IT IS ORDERED, This 4th day of August, 1947, that the approval required by Section 9 of the Shipping Act 1916, as amended (46 U.S.C. 808), of the sale of the steam screw JOHN G. NICOLAY, Official No. 243031, to an alien as above set forth, with transfer to South African registry and flag, be, and it is hereby granted.
