

NOTED THE ONLY SURVIVORS OF THIS CROUNLTY WERE I OF THE UNLICEN-SED CREW WHO WERE ASHORE AT THE TIME OF THE ATTHEN AND SUBSEQUENT EXPLOSION OF SHIP.
