
WHEREAS, The United States Maritime Commission on January 3, 1947, authorized the sale of the Cargo Vessel JOHN L. STODDARD, Official No. 244752, to D. Inglessi Sons, Samos Steamship Company, Commerce, Industry, Inc., a corporation organized under the laws of Greece, with the privilege of transferring said vessel to foreign registry and flag:

IT IS ORDERED, This 25th day of February 1947, that the approval required by Sections 9 and 37 of the Shipping Act 1916, as amended (46 U.S.C. 808 and 835), of the sale of the Cargo Vessel, JOHN L. STODDARD, Official No. 244752, to aliens as above set forth, with transfer to Greek registry and flag, be, and it is hereby granted.
