MEMORANDUM FOR THE CHAIRMAN OF THE CREW DISCIPLINARY COMMITTEE,  
WAR SHIPPING ADMINISTRATION.

The Coast Guard has received reliable information concerning the conduct of various members of the crew of the SS JOHN TRIMBULL during May, 1943.

Michael J. Kelley, oiler; Raymond Kain, fireman-water tender; Norman E. McCloud, fireman-water tender; are reported to have been threatening and abusive to officers of the vessel and intoxicated on board. These men are further reported along with Lawrence Maley, U.S., to have attempted to incite the crew to revolt and to have been generally disturbing.

Necessary action will be instigated by the Coast Guard.
