MEMORANDUM FOR THE CHAIRMAN OF THE CREW DISCIPLINARY COMMITTEE,  
WAR SHIPPING ADMINISTRATION.

The Coast Guard has received information from the Navy concerning Alex Paul, 2nd Ass't. Engineer, serving on the SS JOHN M. BROWN. It is reported that Paul, is suspected of willfully and spitefully causing damage to the vessel's machinery, during May 1943. It is further reported he missed ship and that he performed his duties contrary to established routine, thereby subjecting the vessel to delay.

Action by the Coast Guard is being instigated in this case.
