ITINERARY: Subject vessel departed Savannah, Georgia, 3 May, 1945
enroute to UK.

1. A check of crew list through files of this office revealed Merchant Marine Suspect List, dated 1 September, 1944, listed LENNON, Marion A., Z-105186, age 38, 5'8", fair complexion, brown hair, oiler, as a reported Communist suspect.

2. LENNON, Marion Andrew, Z-105186, oiler aboard the SS "JOHN W. GARRETT" was interviewed and denied having been affiliated with the Communist party at any time. SUBJECT stated he had not been to sea since signing off the SS "WINSTON-SALEM" at Baltimore, Maryland, on 24 March, 1942, and since that time was employed for 2 years in the spare parts division of the St. Johns Shipbuilding Company, Jacksonville, Florida, and 1 year as a warehouse Superintendent for the Moon Pipe and Supply Company, St. Petersburg, Florida.

3. LENNON holds Certificate of Identification, Z-105186, issued 26 August, 1937 at Port Arthur, Texas; CGIC, 06322740, issued 13 April, 1945 at Charleston, South Carolina.

4. The following alien was interrogated and his Maritime Documents found to be previously Indorsed for Security as follows:

BERGE, Henric, Z-418996; CGIC, 031-1307645; AR: 9007467; Yugoslavian Passport, 1832; Second Mate; born 4 December, 1916, Yugoslavia. Third Naval District Security Indorsement dated 24 November, 1944.
