MEMORANDUM FOR THE CHAIRMAN OF THE CREW DISCIPLINARY COMMITTEE,  
WAR SHIPPING ADMINISTRATION.

The Coast Guard has received information from a reliable source alleging that E. Forbes, acting first Mate, of the SS JOSEPH JEFFERSON, during a voyage from Antofagasta to Callao in October, was under the influence of liquor and unable to stand his watch. After arrival in the Port of Callao report further alleges he was again drunk and unable to attend to his duties.

The Coast Guard will instigate whatever disciplinary action is warranted in this case.
