SUBJECT stated that he was formerly employed on the tenker, SS "HATCREEK", and due to spinal injuries, was hospitalized 13 December, 1944, in the Marine Hospital, Gorgas, Panama Canal Zone. He boarded the SS "JOSEPH P. ERADLEY as a workaway, seeking passage to Australia.  LONG, Christopher, born 30 September, 1907, in Glasgow, Scotland weight, 165 lbs., height, 5'9", blue eyes, blonde hair; home address, Sydney, Australia. SUBJECT stated that he had not at any time been issued maritime documents by the United States. Durin the time of his employment on the SS "MISSIONARY RIDGE", he was confined to the Margarita Hospital, Colon, Panama Canal Zone, on 12 February, 1945, for a period of ten days.
