ITINERARY: Arrived Charleston, S. C., from Belgium on 6 June, 1945.

1. Crew list was checked thru the files of this office and revealed the following information on one:

PERLOFF, Jack, listed on M.M.S.L., dated 1 September, 1944. Age 26-28, 140 lbs.; 5'9"; dark brown wavy hair; brown eyes; dark complexion; wears glasses; prominent nose; gold teeth. Training U.S.M.T.S. reported to be a radical Communist. ✓

PERLOFF, Jack, F/WT, aboard SUBJECT vessel is identical with SUBJECT of above information. PERLOFF was interrogated and advised that he was born 12 September, 1916, at Cleveland, Ohio; that his Mother and Father were Russians by birth, and that they came to this country approximately 1912. PERLOFF further advised that he was employed as a Chemist, for Plumbrook Ordnance, Sandusky, Ohio, and was discharged because of a previous conviction on a misdemeanor charge in 1940; that he received a suspended sentence in October, 1940 at Columbus, Ohio, on that charge. PERLOFF advised that that was the only time he had been arrested. PERLOFF further advised that he had been a member of the Communist Party from March, 1940 until September, 1940, at Columbus, Ohio. He joined the National Maritime Union in September, 1944.

PERLOFF sailed on the following ships since his graduation from USMTS in March, 1944: MORMACWREN, TEXAS, MATINICOCK, REVERDY JOHNSON, JOSEPH STANTON.
