ITINERARY: Vessel arrived Savannah, Georgia, at 1915, 22 March, 1945 from UK.

1. Crew list was checked through the files of this office with negative results. The following seamen, who signed on Subject vessel in Cardiff, Wales, were fingerprinted and interrogated:

(a) FINN, Michael Francis, born 14 August, 1924 at Brooklyn, New York; 5'9"; 103 pounds; brown eyes; brown hair; issued certificate of identification Z-530 734 at New York on 21 October, 1944, and bears Third Naval District Security Indorsement dated 21 October, 1944; issued duplicate Coast Guard Identification Card # 031-1038377 at New York on 31 May, 1944. SUBJECT sailed from New York 19 November, 1944 aboard the SS "FLUOR SPAR" and was discharged for hospitalization at Cardiff, Wales on 10 February, 1945. SUBJECT was discharged from the hospital on 24 February, 1945, and was signed on the SS "JOSHUA SLOCUM" as Second Radioman, on 27 February, 1945 at Cardiff, Wales, and arrived Savannah, Georgia, on 22 March, 1945.

(b) FRYE, Antonio, born 16 May, 1916 at Millville, New Jersey; 6'; 165 pounds; brown eyes; black hair; issued Certificate of Identification Z-443164 at New York on 3 November, 1943, and Coast Guard Identification Card # 031-1353127 at New York on 4 November, 1943; U.S. Passport # 162929. SUBJECT signed on the SS "RUBEN DARIO" at New York on
